- 2. Youth Facility – Older Provision:** Members expressed concern regarding the direction of the Youth Provision. It was felt that too much emphasis had been placed on the provision for Younger Children and not as detailed within the Town Council Business Plan which was aimed at 13 years +.

Members did not want the perception of the Youth Facility to be that of young children, years 5 and 6 aged 9-11.

Games consoles that had been purchased would be solely used by the older children with more interactive activities for the junior age group.

An additional Youth Worker would need to be employed in a support role to focus on the older children. Volunteers would also be used.
