

INGLEBY BARWICK TOWN COUNCIL
MINUTES OF THE EVENTS COMMITTEE HELD AT
6.00PM ON THURSDAY 17TH OCTOBER 2019
AT THE RINGS COMMUNITY HUB, INGLEBY BARWICK

Present: Councillors T Strike (Chairman), M Patterson, R Turnbull

1. **Apologies:** Councillor J Irwin.
2. **Declarations of Interest** - Councillor Strike in respect of his role as Chairman of the Ingleby Barwick Community Partnership.
3. **Christmas Events** - Councillor Strike advised that the Ingleby Barwick Community Partnership had the use of a Santa Sleigh which the Town Council would be able to use at a minimal cost. The Clerk had looked to ascertain if the Town Councils insurance would cover the towing of the Sleigh, unfortunately this was not covered under the Town Council Policy and it would be up to the towers Motor Insurance.

It was suggested two nights, one to cover the East Ward and one to cover the West Ward. In order for costs to be covered for Insurance, fuel, sweets for residents and the purchase of a Santa Suit, a budget of up to £500 be requested from the Town Council. **RECOMMENDED** that the Town Council set aside a budget of up to £500 for the 2 night Christmas Event.

4. **Summer Events** - A discussion took place regarding the possibility of hosting a Summer School scheme of events. It was envisaged that a 5 Day Event programme be established incorporating the following events:-

- Football
- Cricket
- Table Tennis
- Rugby
- Rounders/General Sports Day

A request had been submitted to the Town Council from a local Resident regarding the possibility of organising a family fun run in the Town, which could potentially link to the Summer Events. This would be discussed further at the next meeting, where the resident would be invited to attend the meeting.

The Clerk was asked to contact OnSite Building Trust to ascertain if there were any potential dates in August where there were gaps in the diary so that the Rings Community Hub could be utilised as a base for events and that the Summer Events be a standing items on the agenda for future meetings.

5. **Theatre Productions** - At the last meeting of the Committee, it was suggested that an Events programme for the coming year be established which would allow the Events Committee and Town Council to discuss and agree a varied programme which could be

organised and planned in a timely manner to allow maximum participation from interested parties.

Possible future events included:

- Ceilidh
- Touring Panto
- Murder Mystery
- Music Events

AGREED that a full calendar of events be developed and agreed by the Town Council in conjunction with the Events Committee.

6. **Children's Awards Programme** - The Town Council were hoping to develop an awards Scheme with varying categories. This would be the Subject of a future meeting and would be included as an Agenda item in January 2020.
