

**MINUTES OF EXTRAORDINARY MEETING OF INGLEBY TOWN COUNCIL  
HELD AT 4.30 PM ON THURSDAY 1 NOVEMBER 2018 AT BARWICK LODGE**

1. To approve the immediate purchase of an updated 360-degree CCTV camera at Beckfields in the sum of £1,800.00 and the purchase of a new camera for the TESCO roundabout, including monitoring costs, in the sum of £3,900 per annum plus a one-off cost for the column at £1,000.

As this matter had been fully discussed at the Ordinary Town Council meeting, Cllr J. Emmerson proposed, with Cllr. T. Strike seconding, that approval be given. This was unanimously supported.

It was therefore **RESOLVED** to purchase immediately an updated 360-degree CCTV camera for Beckfields in the sum of £1,800.00 and a new camera for the TESCO roundabout, including monitoring costs, in the sum of £3,900 per annum plus a one-off cost for the column at £1,000.
