MINUTES OF THE TOWN MAINTENANCE COMMITTEE HELD AT 6.00 PM
ON TUESDAY 7th JANUARY 2020
AT THE RINGS COMMUNITY HUB, INGLEBY BARWICK

1. **Apologies for absence:** Councillor H Brown
2. **Declarations of Interest:** None
3. **Public Open Space Adoption:** An update on the two possible areas of public open space adoption was submitted. In order for this to be progressed an item would be submitted to the next meeting of the Town Council.
4. **RAF Thornaby Fatalities on Ingleby Barwick:** P Bainbridge submitted information regarding five RAF crashes on Ingleby Barwick during WW2. It was hoped that a memorial could be erected to commemorate the fallen. It was reported that a licence for a memorial from Stockton on Tees Borough Council was required and whether this could be added to the existing memorial would need to be explored. Councillor Kirby had been involved in the original application for the War Memorial so offered to communicate with Stockton-On-Tees Borough Council. It was RECOMMENDED that a sum of £5,000 be built into the 2020/21 Town Council budget.
5. **Ingleby Barwick Community Litter Project update:** P Bainbridge reported that the Community Litter Project continued to patrol on a Wednesday and Saturday and the amount of litter was reducing. The project had been in operation for almost two years. Problems with increased litter continued at All Saints School, it was requested that the Town Clerk contact the Enforcement Service with a view to them visiting the school.
