

**INGLEBY BARWICK TOWN COUNCIL  
MINUTES OF THE EVENTS COMMITTEE

3. **Fun Run – update:** Chris Walker provided members with an update on the Ingleby Barwick Fun Run to take place on Sunday 30th August 2020. It was aimed to launch registration for the run at the end of March and a Facebook page would be established. The following ponsors had been secured:-
