Proposed Community Centre with a Youth Café, The Rings

The Town Council is pleased to announce that it has been successful in its application to obtain 'borrowing approval' from the Secretary of State for Communities, to take out a loan not exceeding £725,000, towards the building and construction of The Rings Community Centre. It is expected that the loan will be taken out over a 25-year period, with the repayments made through the Town Council's annual precept.

It is anticipated that work on site will commence in early/mid 2018 with completion hopefully late 2018.

The Town Council welcomes comments from residents' as the project progresses and would also like to hear from any interested user groups.
